



# Finishing Instructions for Above the Buffet

## Fabric Requirements for Finishing *Above the Buffet*

### Shelf Fabric (Same as Shelf Accent Fabric)

$\frac{1}{4}$  yard

Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (18) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cut (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (15) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cornerstone squares

### Woodgrain Fabric

$\frac{5}{8}$  yard

Cut (1) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (20) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cut (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

### Border Fabric

1 $\frac{3}{8}$  yards

Cut (5) 6" strips

Cut (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (binding)

All seam allowances should be a  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

## Vertical Lattice (*Woodgrain*)

1. Arrange blocks in a pleasing manner. Sew a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Woodgrain Lattice rectangle between all blocks in each row.

Press seams toward Vertical Lattice.

## Horizontal Lattice (*Shelf Fabric*)

2. Sew 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cornerstone squares between each of (6) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Shelf Fabric rectangles.

Repeat two more times.

Press seams toward 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

## Sewing the Rows Together

3. Sew a Horizontal Lattice to lower edge of three upper rows, matching cornerstone seams to Vertical Lattice seams.

Press seams toward Lattice.

4. Sew the four rows together, matching seams at cornerstones.

Press seams toward Lattice.

# Shelf Top, Bottom and Sides

*(Woodgrain Inner Border)*

5. Measure the two sides and vertical center of quilt top.  
Using the average measurement, cut (2) 2½" wide strips and sew to both ends of quilt top.  
Press seams toward inner border (Woodgrain).
6. Measure the length of top, bottom and horizontal center of quilt top.  
Sew the remaining (3) 2½" strips together, end to end. Using the average measurement, cut (2) 2½" wide strips and sew to both sides of quilt top.  
Press seams toward inner border (Woodgrain).

## Border

7. Measure the two sides and vertical center of quilt top.  
Using an average measurement, cut (2) 6" wide strips and sew to both sides of quilt top.  
Press seams toward outer border.
8. Measure the length of top, bottom and horizontal center of quilt top.  
Sew the remaining (3) 6" strips together, end to end. Using an average measurement, cut (2) 6" wide strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt top.  
Press seams toward outer border.
9. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) binding strips together. Bind quilt in your favorite method.
