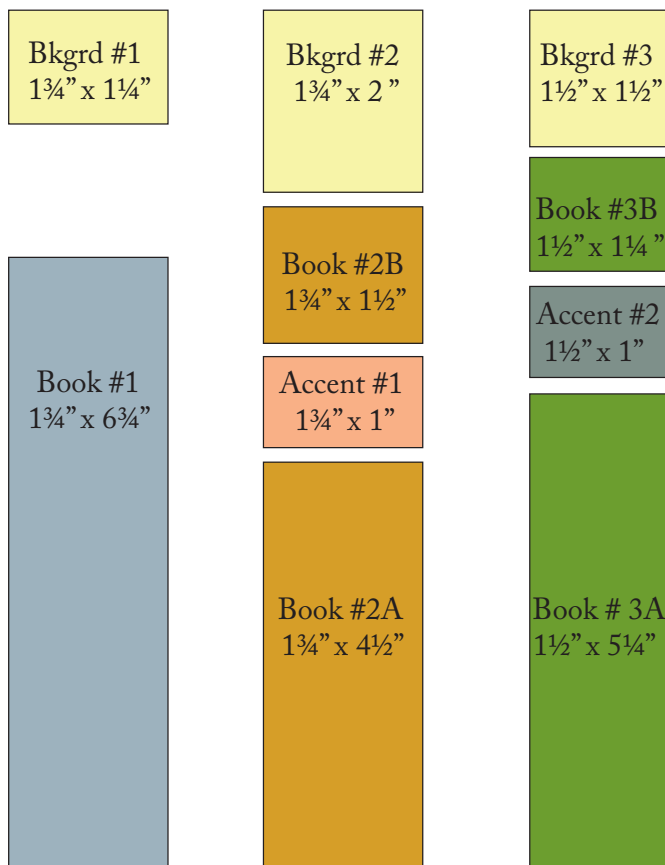

## Fabric Requirements for One Finished 6" x 7" Block

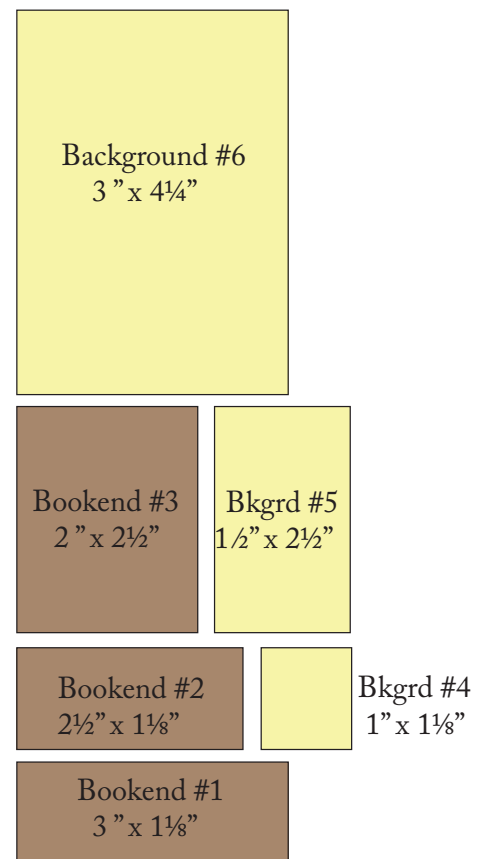
- (1) 5" x 8" Background Fabric
- (1) 2" x 7" Book 1 Fabric
- (1) 2" x 7" Book 2 Fabric
- (1) 2" x 7" Book 3 Fabric
- (1) 1" x 2" Accent Fabric 1
- (1) 1" x 2" Accent Fabric 2
- (1) 5" x 5" Bookend Fabric

All seam allowances should be a scant 1/4".  
Make three blocks for quilt, one as shown,  
and two mirror images.

1. Cut Book and Background fabrics as shown in Cutting Diagrams for three books.



2. Cut Bookend and Background fabrics as shown in the Cutting Diagram for the Bookend.



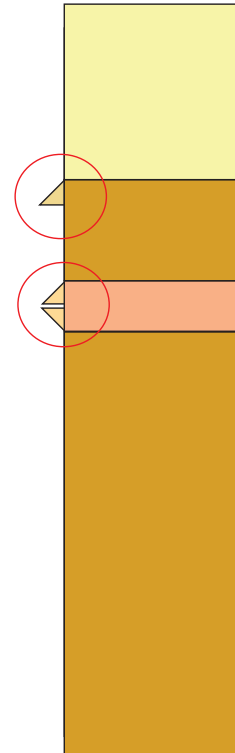
## Book 1

1. Sew Background #1 to Book #1.  
Press seam toward Book.



## Book 2

2. Sew Accent #1 between Book #2A and Book #2B.  
Press seams toward Accent #1.  
Sew Background #2 to Book #2B.  
Press seam toward Book.



## Book 3

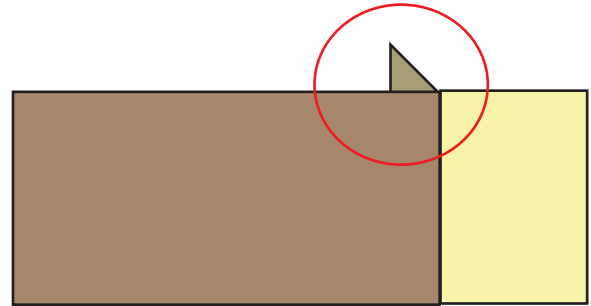
3. Sew Accent #2 between Book #3A and Book #3B.  
Press seams toward Accent #2.  
Sew Background #3 to Book #3B.  
Press seam toward Book.



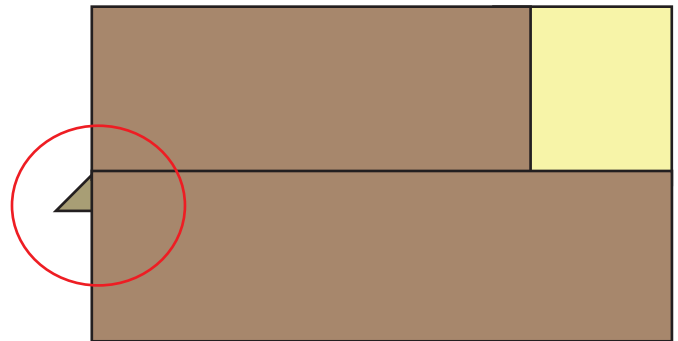
## Bookend

### Lower Bookend

4. Sew Background #4 to Bookend #2.  
Press seam to Bookend.

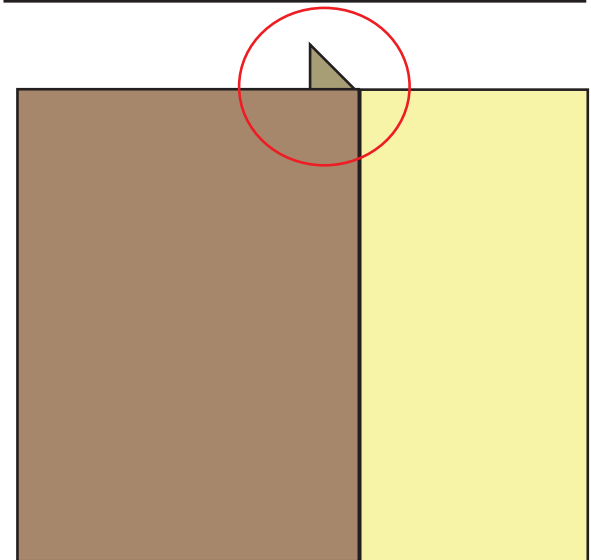


5. Sew this unit to Bookend #1.  
Press seam to Bookend #1.



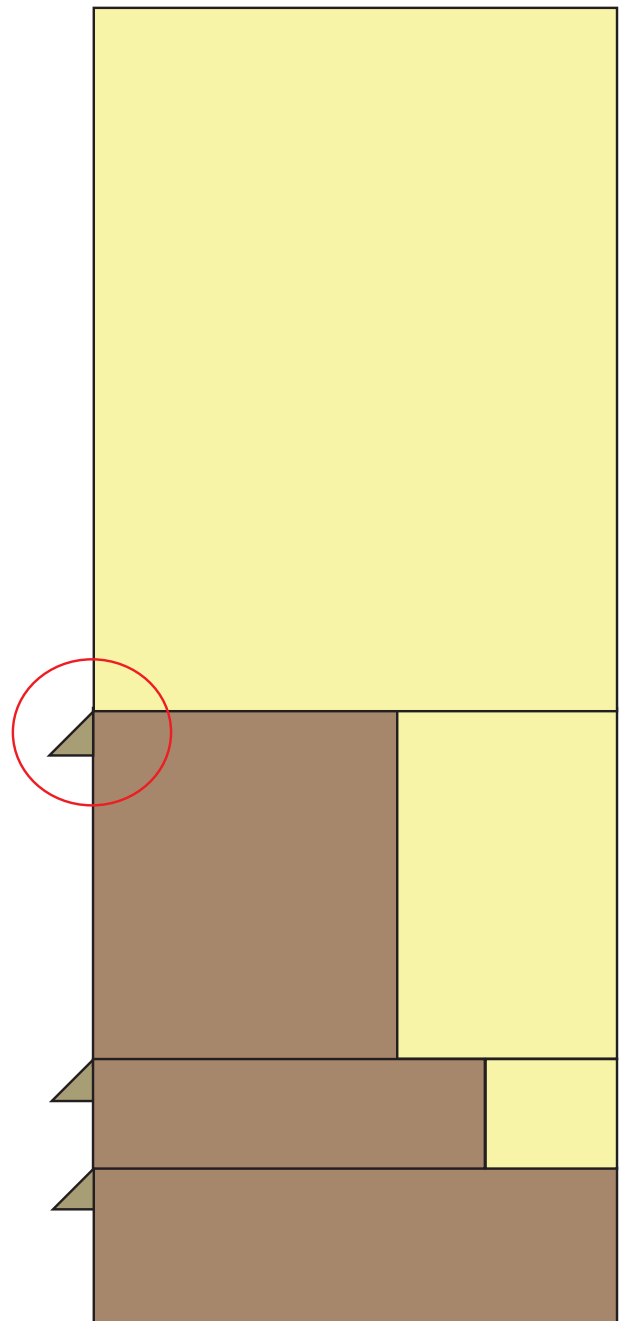
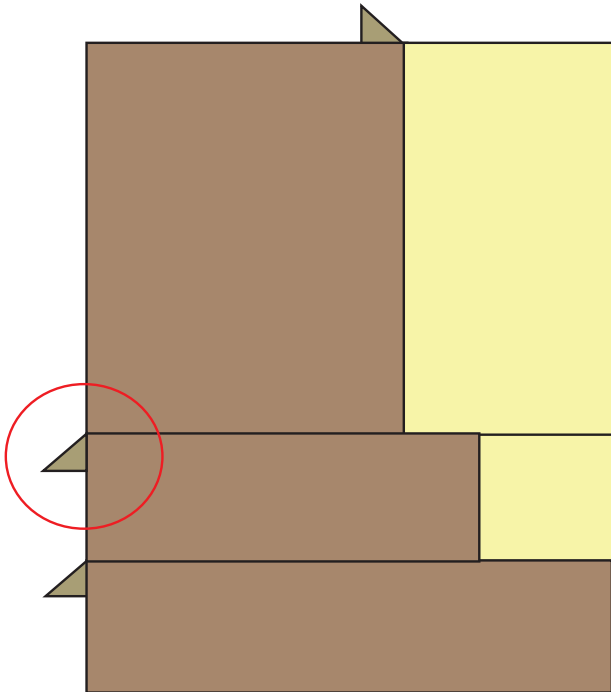
### Upper Bookend

6. Sew Background #5 to Bookend #3.  
Press seam to Bookend.

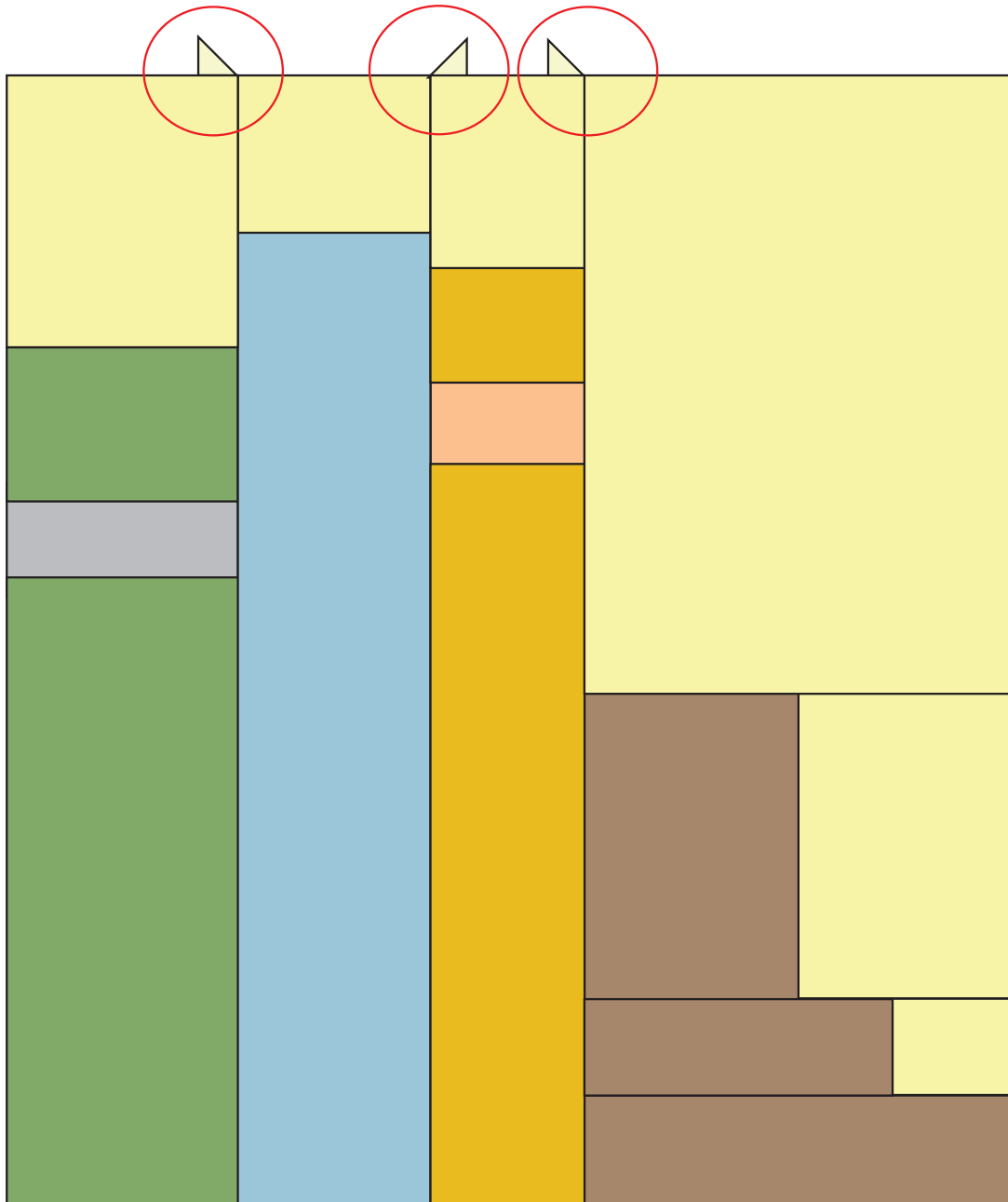


7. Sew upper Bookend to lower Bookend.  
Press seam to lower Bookend.

8. Sew Background #6 to upper edge of Bookend.  
If needed, square up to 7 1/2" x 3".



9. Sew the books together in any order. If needed, square up to 7 ½" x 4". Sew the bookend to right side of books. Press seams as shown.



10. To make a mirror image **Books and Bookend Block**, reverse the background sections of bookend and sew the books to opposite side.
