Fabric Requirements for One Finished 6" x 7" Block

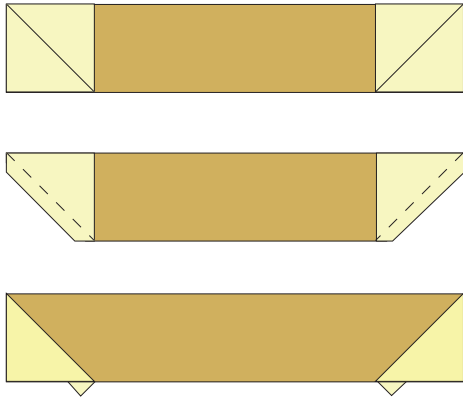
- (1) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" Background Fabric
- (4) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Background Fabric
- (2) 1 1/4" x 2 3/4" Background Fabric
- (1) 2 3/4" x 5" Bowl Fabric
- (1) 1 1/4" x 6 1/2" Rim Fabric

All seam allowances should be a scant 1/4".
Make three blocks for quilt.

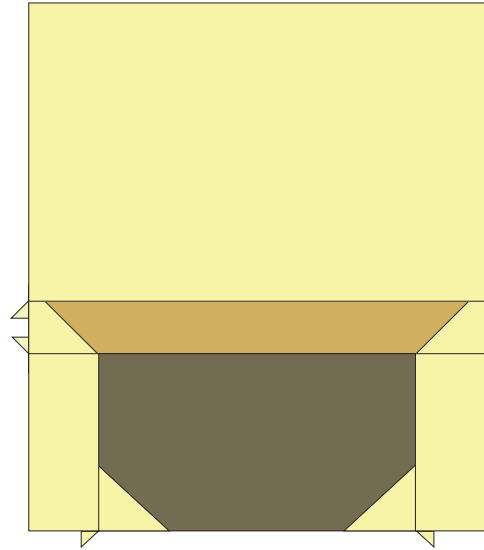
1. Place 1 1/4" Background Squares on two lower corners of Bowl Fabric. Draw diagonal lines as shown. Sew on each line and trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press seams toward bowl.
2. Sew a 1 1/4" x 2 3/4" Background rectangles to each side of bowl. Press seams toward bowl.



3. Place 1 ¼" Background Squares on both ends of Rim Fabric. Draw diagonal lines as shown. Sew on the lines and trim seam allowances to ¼". Press seams toward Background Squares.



5. Sew 4 ½" x 6 ½" Background rectangle to top edge of Rim. Press seam toward Rim.



4. Sew Rim to top edge of Bowl with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seam toward Rim.
