

Three Boxes

- (2) 2" x 3" Background Fabric
- (1) 5" x 1" Background Fabric
- (1) 4½" x 2¾" Background Fabric
- (1) 4" x 1" Background Fabric
- (1) 4" x 3¼" Background Fabric
- (1) 9" x 3" Large Box Fabric
- (1) 5" x 1" Small Box Fabric
- (1) 5" x 21¼" Medium Box Fabric

All seam allowances should be a scant ¼".
Adjust seam allowances if necessary.

1. Sew a 2" x 3" Background rectangle to each end of 9½" x 3" Large Box rectangle.
2. Press seams toward background rectangles.

When complete Unit 1 should measure 12½" x 3"



UNIT 1

3. Sew a 5" x 1" Background rectangle to top edge of 5" x 2¼" Medium Box rectangle.
4. Press seam toward upper edge.

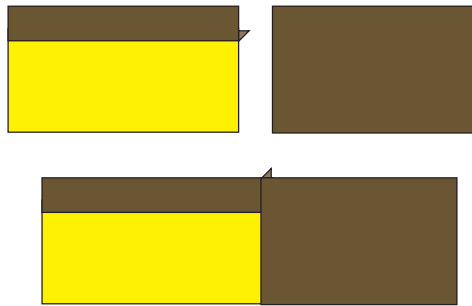
When complete Unit 2 should measure 5" x 2¾"



UNIT 2

5. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Background rectangle to right edge of Medium Box.
6. Press seam toward Background rectangle.

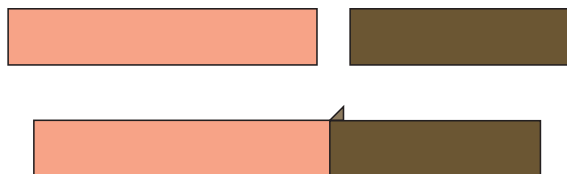
When complete Unit 3 should measure 9" x $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".



UNIT 3

6. Sew a 4" x 1" Background rectangle to right end of $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" Small Box rectangle.
7. Press seam toward Background rectangle.

When complete Unit 4 should measure 9" x 1".

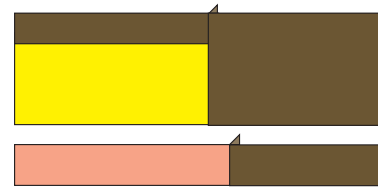


UNIT 4

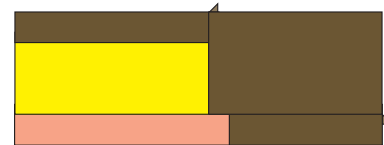
8. Sew Unit 4 to lower edge of Unit 3.

9. Press seam toward lower edge.

When complete, Unit 5 should measure 9" x 3¼".



UNIT 5



10. Sew a 4" x 3¼" Background rectangle to left edge of Unit 5.

11. Press seam toward Background rectangle.

When complete, Unit 4 should measure 12½" x 3¼".



UNIT 6



12. Sew Unit 1 to lower edge of Unit 6.

13. Press seam toward upper edge.

When complete, Unit 4 should measure 12½" x 5¾".
