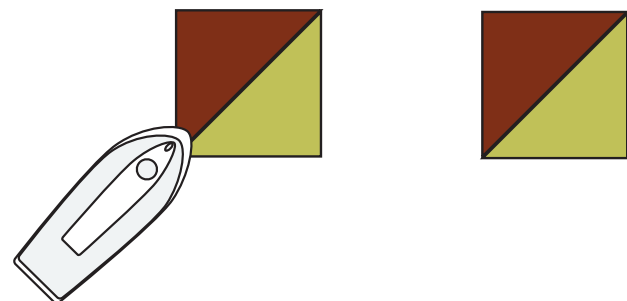
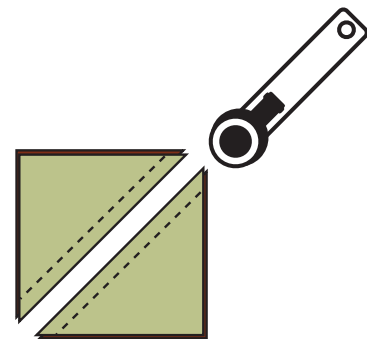
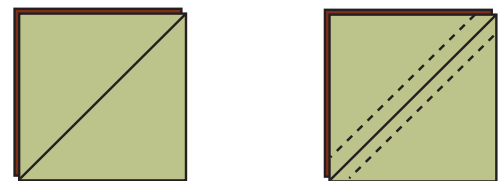
Fabric Requirements for one Finished 6" x 7" Block

- (1) 4 ¼" square Background (will make two quarter square triangles)
- (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Background rectangle
- (1) 3 ½" x 7 ½" Background rectangle
- (1) 4 ¼" Goblet square (will make two quarter square triangles)
- (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Goblet rectangle

Make ten blocks in a variety of colors.

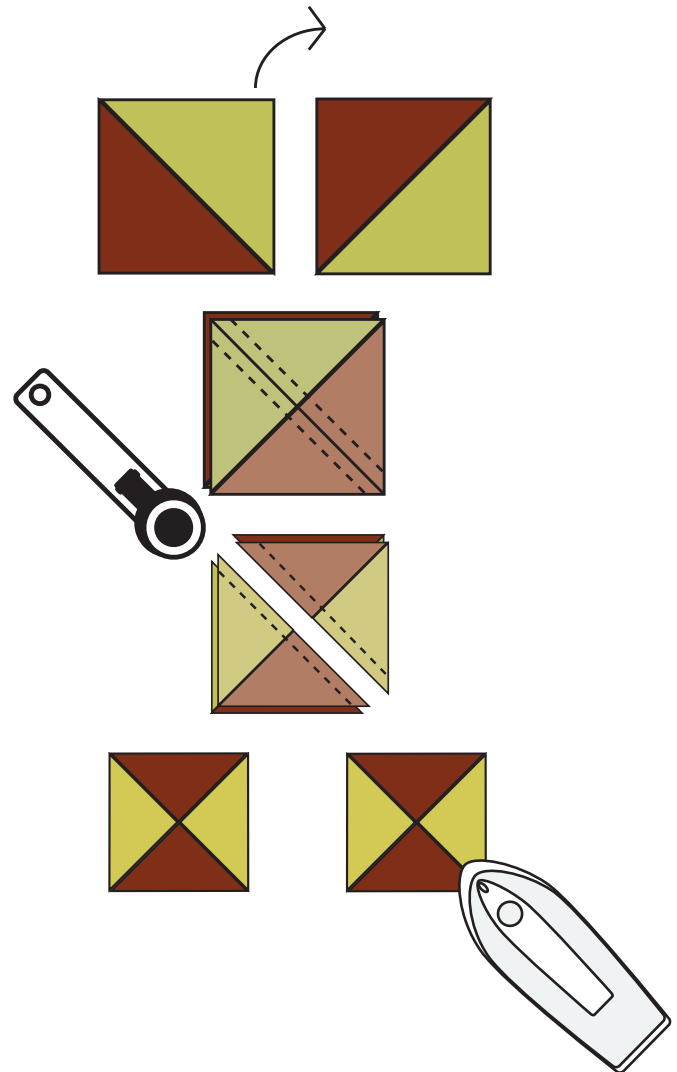
Sew with a scant ¼" seam allowance

1. Stack one 4 ¼" Background square and one 4 ¼" Goblet square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on top square.
2. Stitch a scant ¼" away from both sides of line.
3. Cut apart on drawn line, making two identical half square triangles.
4. Press seam allowance to darker side.

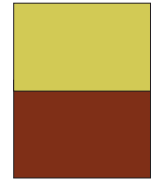


5. Stack two half square triangles on top of each other, opposite colors touching and right sides together.
6. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner and perpendicular to previous seam.
7. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of line.
8. Cut apart on drawn line, making two identical quarter square triangles.
9. Press seam allowance to one side.

Trim "dog ears".
 Silver trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square if necessary.

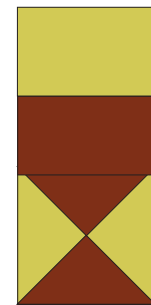


10. Stitch a 2 ½" x 3 ½" Background rectangle to a 2 ½" x 3 ½" Goblet rectangle.



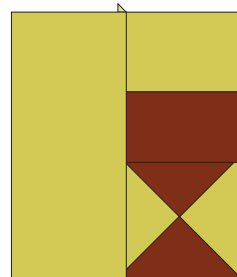
11. Press seam toward Goblet.

12. Sew the Goblet top to the quarter square triangle (Wine Goblet base) with a ¼" seam allowance.



13. Press seam toward Goblet.

14. Sew a 3 ½" x 7 ½" Background rectangle to the one side of Wine Goblet with a ¼" seam allowance.



15. Press seam toward Background.

Note: Make five Wine Goblets with background rectangle on the left side and five Wine Goblets with background rectangle on the right side.
